Galway Models

Conditions *(Please read carefully)*

1. The staff will contact the customer at the start of production, approximately 5-6 months before estimated delivery. When we are ready to begin production, we will confirm your order specifications and a 50% non-refundable deposit will then be required to start construction. The balance must also be paid after completion prior to shipping or pickup of the instrument (down payment is preferred with checks). A 6.25% sales tax must be added to any items picked-up or shipped within the state of Massachusetts.
2. For instrument with Silver mechanism: the final purchase price is determined by the date when the order is placed. If the customer is not ready to begin the production of their order at the time we reach their name in the waiting list, the customer may request a maximum of 3 month delay while keeping their price lock. However, prices can be locked only up to 12 months from the initial order date. Any delays further than 12 months will result in an annulment of the price lock, and the current prices of the company would then apply to the order. For instrument with Gold mechanism: Kanichi Nagahara is the only one who makes the All Gold flutes (tube, toneholes and mechanism). For this reason, the waiting period is significantly longer than those made with Silver mechanism. The final purchase price is determined by the date the order starts production. Once we reach your order, the staff will contact you with the price quote at which time you are free to accept or decline the production start.
3. Changes or cancellation to an order can be made at any time before production begins with no penalty fee. However, any changes must be requested formally in writing (with a signature) before production begins.
4. Headjoints can be exchanged within six months after the delivery date for complete flute orders only. If the exchange is an upgrade, the difference must be paid by the customer at the time of exchange. Any exchange request after the 6 month period may be granted with a 15% restocking fee.
5. A leather case, nylon case cover, wooden cleaning rod, silk swab, and cleaning cloth are included. Three COA annual checkups (with UPS 2nd DAY return shipping) are also included. The complementary Cleaning, Oiling and Adjustments must be used within the first 3 years of ownership and are non-transferable.
